Introduction

As the European Commission's scientific service, the JRC addresses key societal challenges, providing EU policy makers with independent, evidence-based scientific and technical support required for EU policy making.

JRC-Geel employs about 250 individuals who work on biotechnology, food and feed safety, food fraud detection, healthcare, nanotechnology, nuclear safety and security, and threat detection. These activities are conducted in state-of-the-art laboratories and facilities.

Tasks

- Liaise with Commission rules and procedures related to social welfare, including sickness insurance, with national or regional legislation and contribute to finding solutions for problems reported;
- Advise and help staff and their family members coping with difficulties such as invalidity, family or financial problems, or with problems related to the work environment and social integration;
- Maintain liaison with retired staff and their families living in the region, providing support where required;
- Maintain contacts and liaise with the social services of the European Commission and other JRC sites;
- Addressing other psychosocial needs in the domains of prevention, welcome services, aid and assistance, help and guidance in family and relation crises, divorce assistance and mediation, advice for youth, crisis shelter, victim support services, etc;
